Each trainee has the chance to operate the machinery and practice the skills they learned throughout Theory Training under the program trainer's helpful eye in a setting that is safety controlled.

Practical Evaluation

The Practical Evaluation is where the trainees are assessed to assure they have reached a minimum level of skill. The ones training are then assessed on an individual basis utilizing the machinery in a reasonably difficult course setting.
