The employers working in this business operating heavy machinery will typically be trained by taking a formal apprenticeship program or by receiving on-the-job training by their companies or unions. It is necessary that employers hire fully-trained heavy equipment operators to adhere to local rules and comply with regional and local laws regarding job situations and worker safety.
