Richmond Hill Zoom Boom Ticket - Zoom Boom Training is intended to train operators on variable reach forklifts. The goals of the training are to impart an understanding of the physics of the equipment, and to be able to outline the operator's tasks. This program abides by North American safety standards for lift trucks. Zoom boom training and certification is obtainable at the company's location or at our site, provided there are a minimum number of individuals training. Certification received upon successfully completing it is valid for three years.

The telehandler or telescopic handler is similar in numerous ways to a crane and a common forklift. This versatile machinery is made along with a telescopic boom which can lift upwards and extend forward. Different attachments could be fitted on the end of the boom, like for instance pallet forks, bucket, muck grab or lift table. It is popular in industry and agriculture settings.

The telehandler is a common used with fork attachments to be able to enable the shuttling of loads. Telehandlers have the advantage of being able to reach those inaccessible places that can't be reached by a common forklift. Telehandlers are capable of removing palletized loads from inside a trailer and placing them on high places like for instance rooftops. For certain applications, they could be more practical and efficient than a crane.

When lifting heavy loads, the telehandler can experience some unsteadiness. When the boom is extended too far with a load, the machine would become more unstable. Counterweights in the rear help, but don't solve the problem. The lifting capacity rapidly decreases when the working radius increases. Some equipment come with front outriggers that extend the lifting capacity while the machinery is stationary.
